### Abstract Guidelines

1. Abstract submission must be online through this link:  
<https://ngusop.meetinghand.net/>
2. **The abstract submission deadline is till 16<sup>th</sup> of June 2023.**
3. Upon acceptance of the abstract, the corresponding author will be notified via email.
4. Abstract should be allocated into one of the following fields:
  - Microbiology and Immunology
  - Phytochemistry and herbal medicine
  - Drug discovery and medicinal chemistry
  - Digital health
  - Pharmaceutical technology and nano-drug delivery
  - Pharmacology and Toxicology
  - Drug analysis and quality control
  - Clinical pharmacy practice and patient care
  - Molecular biology
5. Abstract language: English (spelled and grammar checked)
6. Abstract Title
  - Should be clear, concise, and informative of the field of your research.
7. Abstract Body
  - Word limit: 150-200 words, including spaces (please track your character count before submission).
  - It should contain a brief introduction, objectives, methodology, results, and conclusions.
8. Keywords
  - About 3-5 key words, arranged alphabetically.



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## Poster Guidelines

1. The poster size should be 122 cm width x 92 cm height (48 x 36 in). All posters must be in "landscape" format.
2. Posters should be readable 1-2 meters away. Therefore, **font size should not be less than 24-36 points** is preferable to enable easy reading.
3. Proofread: Check spelling, grammar, and punctuation.
4. Poster title: should match exactly the title of your accepted abstract. Use Boldface with font size not less than 48 points at the top middle of the poster. Capitalize each word in the title.
5. Author and Co-authors' names and affiliations must be added just below the poster title in italic with font size not less than 24 points.
  - Author(s) Name(s): Include full first name and family name.
  - The corresponding author should be marked with an asterisk (\*). Otherwise, the order of the names may vary depending on the preference of the authors.
  - Affiliation details: department, institution, city, and country. Different affiliations should be given superscripted numbers (1, 2, ....) unless all authors are from the same affiliation (no need to add a number).
6. Your **institution logo** must be added on the top-right hand-side of the poster.
7. The **assigned poster code** must be added on the top-left hand-side of the poster.
8. We recommend using white or light color-background and use figures to convey the objectives of your poster.
9. Recommended Headings to follow: Introduction or Background, Objectives or Aim, Methods, Results, Conclusion and References.

## Poster Presentation Instructions

- The posters will be organized by the field and labeled with a specific code.
- Hang your poster on the board labelled with your specific code at the beginning of the day.
- Check the timing of the poster session from the Program Agenda.
- Presenters should arrive at the poster session venue 10 minutes prior to the start time and remain for the entire session.
