### 1. Informative talk: Climate change Global crisis.

- Dr Radwa Ewisha had given a workshop tackling the global climate change challenges, followed by Q and A s session. Dr. Radwa also gave a glimpse of Egypt’s preparedness to COP 27 and current solutions to combat climate change. The workshop mainly targeted year 1 students as part of school of pharmacy orientation sessions, however, all students through different batches were also invited to attend. Staff members and teaching assistants attended the workshop too.

### 2. International day for the “Elimination of violence against women” and Hospice Egypt Fundraising event

The students were for girls only from all the 5 cohorts. The participation fees went to support Hospice Egypt project supports terminally ill patients; socially, financially, and economically. SOP staff and students help raise funds for the noble goals of Hospice Egypt through charitable events and football tournaments.

The event was preceded by a talk by Dr. Rehab Shamma, a professor of pharmaceuticals and industrial pharmacy in Cairo University. The talk gave the students a glimpse of Multiple sclerosis as a disease and what are the most common symptoms experienced by the patient. Engineer Peter, one of the MS support group also gave a talk about the misconceptions of multiple sclerosis and the need for psychological support. After the talk, the clubs distributed flyers in the plaza, and involved the students in many activities mimicking MS symptoms.

**9. Campaign: RAMADAN Boxes.**

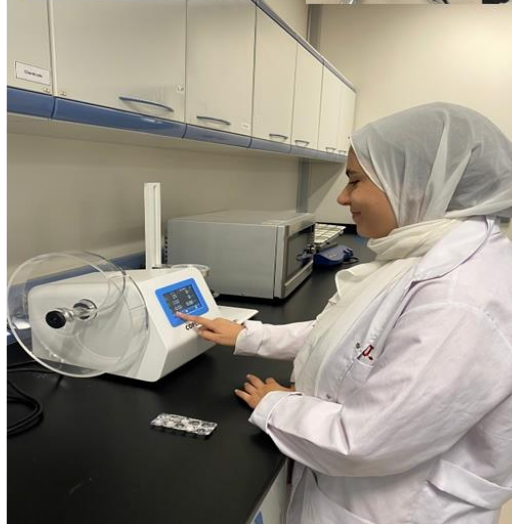
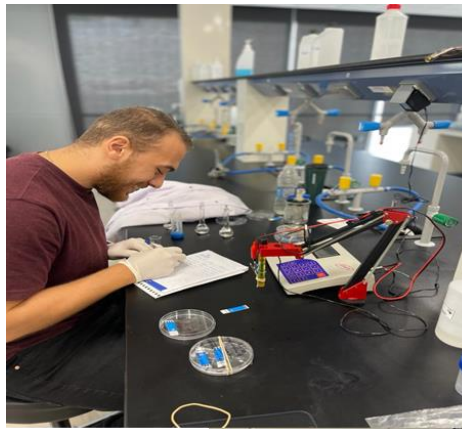
