Initiation and Registration Procedure

- Clubs present their ideas through the Student Life and Activities office.
- Meetings are conducted for planning, brainstorming ideas, and providing support and connections.
- Student leaders are required to do an online booking request for their activities using the Student Life and Activities Event Request form (***Contact the Student Life Office for the form***).
- The activities are medium or large scale, they are required to submit a proposal for approval.
